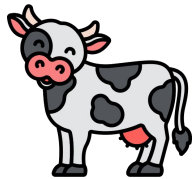

Animals and the Human Body

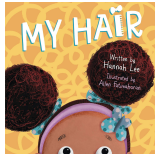
England



Reading & Writing

In English we will:

- read RWI books to develop our reading fluency
- read books as a class to develop our comprehension skills
- punctuate sentences using capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks



Maths

We will be learning to:

- read, write and tell the time to o'clock and half past on an analogue clock
- sequence daily activities
- represent, sequence, explore and compare 2-digit numbers
- count in 2s, 5s and 10s
- describe and complete number patterns

Science

We will continue to learn how to:

- identify a variety of common animals from different animal groups and their features
- identify carnivores, herbivores and omnivores
- identify and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense

Geography

We will be learning to:

- name and locate the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom
- use a key to identify physical and human features on a map
- use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the UK and its countries

PE

We have a PE lesson every **Wednesday** and **Friday**. Please ensure the children wear a PE kit on those days.

The focus of the sessions will be fitness and gymnastics.



RE

This term our focus will be on **Faith Communities**.

We will be learning to:

- discuss what is special about belonging to a group
- know that some people belong to different religions
- understand some key ceremonies and events across religions and identify ways in which they show people belong
