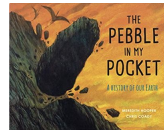
Settlements



Reading & Writing

In English we will be:

- reading SFA/RWI books at our level to develop our fluency and comprehension
- writing persuasively using *Wolves in the Walls*
- writing explanation texts using *The Pebble in my Pocket*
- using sentences with conjunctions to add detail and explain



Maths

We will be learning:

- the multiplication and division facts for 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 10
- to multiply and divide by 10 and 100
- to multiply and divide a 2-digit number by 2, 3, 4 and 5
- to divide 2-digit by a 1-digit



Science

We will be learning to:

- compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties
- describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock
- recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter

Geography

We will be learning to:

- describe different types of settlements and know their features
- know the difference between urban and rural locations
- describe the topography of settlements in the UK and discuss patterns of land use

PE

We have a PE lesson every **Tuesday and Thursday** so please wear a PE kit on those days.

The focus of the sessions will be gymnastics and cricket.



RE

This term our focus will be on **Beliefs about God**.

We will be learning to:

- describe some of the ways in which Christians, Hindus and Muslims describe God
- suggest why having a faith or belief in something can be hard
- identify how and say why it makes a difference to people's lives to believe in God
