Hackney's History



Reading & Writing

In English we will:

- read RWI books to develop our reading fluency and comprehension
- use past and present tenses correctly
- use subordination (when, if, that, or) and coordination (or, and, but)



Maths

We will be learning about:

- drawing and measuring lengths in centimetres
- Represent and interpret pictograms and tally charts
- calculate the 2, 5 and 10 times tables by skip counting
- use pictorial representations to write multiplication and division equations

Science

We will be learning to:

- Identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, and glass for particular uses
- Find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching

History

We will be learning:

- why people chose to move to Hackney
- the stories of people who have moved to Hackney, including why they moved and how their lives changed

PE

We have a PE lesson every **Monday and Wednesday** so please ensure the children wear a PE kit on those days.

The focus of the sessions will be fitness and gymnastics



PSHE

This term our focus will be on **'Celebrating Difference'**.
