English

In English we will be:

- reading books at our level to develop fluency and comprehension.
- writing a legend and building our own mythical creatures inspired by **Beowulf**.
- writing an explanation text using You Wouldn't Want to be an Anglo-Saxon Peasant.





Maths

We will be learning to:

- tell the time using both the 12 hour and 24 hour clock.
- convert between units of time.
- convert fractions to decimals including tenths, quarters and halves.
- compare and order numbers with the same number of decimal places.
- multiply and divide by 10 and 100 including decimals.
- find the area and perimeter of shapes.

Science

In science, we will complete our **Electricity** unit and begin our **Identification and Classification** unit.

- design circuits with different components including switches.
- recognise common conductors and insulators.
- identify and group a variety of living things in the local environment.
- use and create classification keys to name living things found in different habitats.

History

Our history topic is **The Anglo Saxons.** We will be learning:

- what Britain was like after Roman rule.
- why the Anglo-Saxons came to Britain.
- how the Anglo-Saxons lived and ruled.
- the impact of Christianity on the Anglo-Saxons.
- how we know so much about Anglo-Saxon life.

Computing

Our computing topic is **Data Logging.** We will be learning to:

- use sequence, selection, and repetition in programs
- work with variables and various forms of input and output.
