Re: Practice SATs

As you are aware, our Year 6 children will be completing their end of KS2 SATs in May 2023. We have very high aspirations for the children and want for them to do as well as they possibly can. Those children who do well in the tests will be far better prepared for secondary school.

We are sure that, by carrying out regular assessments, not only will we have a good understanding of what support each pupil needs, we will also be confident that our children are well prepared for tests and feel at ease with the arrangements in place.

Next week, our children will sit mock SATs in Reading, Maths, Grammar and Spelling.

Throughout the week, the Year 6 children will complete practice papers under the same conditions as the main tests in May.

The children will complete the tests over the following days:

- Monday 10th October - Spelling & Grammar
- Tuesday 11th October - Reading
- Wednesday 12th October - Mathematics 1 & 2
- Thursday 13th October - Mathematics 3

For some pupils with additional needs, access arrangements will be in place, including additional time to complete the tests. Mr Davids will write to these parents separately.
