






Dear Year 6 Families

As we near the Year 6 SATs assessments, we felt it would be useful to share some top tips on how to support revision at home during the half term break and beyond.

- Do little and often in terms of work at home. (Weekly set homework should be completed)
- Keep revision light. Going over key skills (times tables, real world mental maths as you are shopping or cooking) is a good way to keep revision light.
- As we said before, **avoid using past papers.**

There are plenty of free or inexpensive SATs practice materials for parents available. If you're looking to support your child further with revision at home, the information below provides a great starting point.
