Re: Practice SATs

As you are aware, our Year 6 children will be completing their end of KS2 SATs in May 2023. We have very high aspirations for the children and want for them to do as well as they possibly can. Those children who do well in the tests will be far better prepared for secondary school.

We are sure that, by carrying out regular assessments, not only will we have a good understanding of what support each pupil needs, we will also be confident that our children are well prepared for tests and feel at ease with the arrangements in place.

During the weeks commencing **13th March 2023 & 20th March 2023**, our children will sit mock SATs in Reading, Maths, Grammar and Spelling. These will take place over the two weeks due to the school closures on the 15th and 16th of March.

Throughout the week, the Year 6 children will complete practice papers under the same conditions as the main tests in May.

For some pupils with additional needs, access arrangements will be in place, including additional time to complete the tests.
