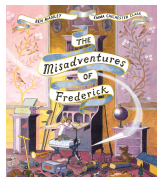

Reading & Writing

In English we will:

- read RWI books to develop our reading fluency and comprehension
- describing a setting
- writing a postcard based on *Meerkat Mail*
- retelling the story of *The Misadventures of Frederick*
- writing a letter to Frederick



Maths

We will be learning about:

- the time on an analogue clock
- calculating durations of time
- fractions as part of a whole
- equivalent fractions
- addition and subtraction of 2-digit numbers



Science

We will continue to learn how to:

- identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, and glass for particular uses
- find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching

Geography

We will be learning to:

- understand geographical similarities and differences between the United Kingdom and Alexandria in Egypt
- identify physical and human features of each place
- use world maps, atlases and globes

PE

We have a PE lesson every **Monday** and **Wednesday**. Please ensure the children wear a PE kit on those days.

The focus of the sessions will be fitness and gymnastics



RE

This term our focus will be on **Jewish Beliefs**.

We will be learning to:

- know that Jewish people believe in God
- understand that Shabbat is a special day of the week and understand how it is celebrated
- know about the festival of Hanukkah and understand what it means to Jewish people
