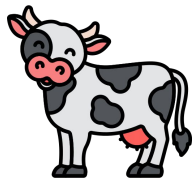

Reading & Writing

In English we will:

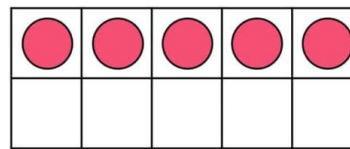
- read RWI books to develop our reading fluency
- read books as a class to develop our comprehension skills
- join words and clauses using 'and'
- begin to punctuate sentences using a question



Maths

We will be learning to:

- using and following instructional and positional language
- identifying, comparing and ordering numbers to 20
- adding and subtracting numbers within 20



Science

We will be learning to:

- identify a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals
- identify a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores
- identify and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense

History

We will be learning to:

- what history is and how we use sources to find out information about the past
- how timelines are used to show chronology
- how people who are older than us can tell us what life was like in the past
