In English we will be:

We will be learning to:

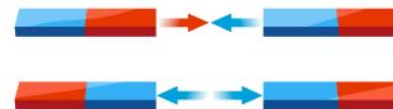
- Develop and use a range of mental calculation strategies

- Add and subtract lengths
- Calculate perimeter
- Understanding multiplicative relationships: commutativity and inverse
- Exploring multiplication and division facts for 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 10



## Science

We will be learning about forces and magnets and to:

- Describe how magnets have two poles.
- Observe how magnets repel and attract each other
- Identify some magnetic materials.
- Explore how objects move on different surfaces.



## History

We will be learning about:

- When the periods of the Stone, Bronze and iron Age occurred;
- How people lived during the Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic ages in Britain;
- How the invention and bronze and iron impacted daily life in Britain.
