Forces and Magnets

Stone Age to Iron Age



Reading & Writing

In English we will be:

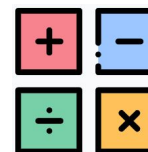
- reading SFA/RWI books at our level to develop our reading fluency and comprehension
- using conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions in our writing
- using direct speech including inverted commas



Maths

We will be learning about:

- develop and use a range of mental calculation strategies
- explain how to use the column method to add and subtract numbers
- measure, draw and compare lengths
- calculate the perimeter of shapes



Science

We will be learning to:

- Compare how things move on different surfaces
- Notice that some forces need contact between two objects but magnetic forces can act at a distance
- Group materials based on whether they are attracted to a magnet

History

We will be learning:

- how daily life changed during the Stone Age
- how the discovery of Bronze impacted daily life
- how the discovery of iron impacted daily life



PE

We have a PE lesson every **Tuesday and Thursday** so please wear a PE kit on those days.

The focus of the sessions will be fitness and gymnastics.



PSHE

This term our focus will be on **'Celebrating Difference'**.

Pupils will explore the importance of self-respect. This will include recognising respectful behaviour.
