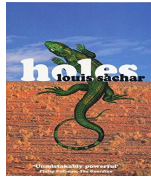


English

In English we will be:

- reading *Holes* by Louis Sachar, making inferences and writing our own adventure story, developing a character using dialogue and describing a setting
- writing an explanation text about how to survive Camp Green Lake



Maths

We will be learning how to:

- describe, draw and reflect shapes
- recognise and construct 3D shapes
- read, write and convert between units of measures
- calculate area of parallelograms, triangles and cuboids



Science

Our science topic is **Light**. We will be learning to:

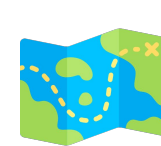
- recognise and prove that light appears to travel in straight lines
- explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from sources to objects and then our eyes
- explain why shadows have the same shape as objects



Geography

Our geography topic is **What's it like there?** We will be learning to:

- locate the world's countries, using maps to focus on Europe and North and South America
- focus on environmental regions of certain countries, key physical and human features and major cities
