Plants and their Life Cycles

Ancient Egyptians



Reading & Writing

In English we will be:

- Reading SFA/RWI books at our level to develop our fluency and comprehension.
- Writing a magic moral story inspired by *The Magic Finger*, using writing techniques to build tension.
- Writing an autobiography in the style of *Coming to England*.



Maths

We will be learning to:

- Tell the time using both analogue and digital clocks.
- Measure, calculate and compare durations of time.
- Describe fractions as a part of a whole.
- Find fractions of a quantity or shape.
- Add, subtract, compare and order fractions.

Science

We will be learning to:

- Identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers.
- Investigate the way in which water is transported within plants.
- Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth and how they vary from plant to plant.



History

We will be learning about:

- The Ancient Egyptians and their beliefs.
- Mummification and burial practices.
- Why we are able to know so much about the lives of Ancient Egyptians.
- How artefacts at the British Museum can teach us about life in the past.

PE

We have a PE lesson every **Tuesday and Thursday** so please wear a PE kit on those days.

The focus of the sessions will be rounders and basketball.

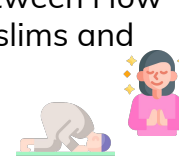


RE
