## READING


We will be:

- Reading SFA/RWI books at our level to develop our reading fluency.
- DEAR sessions to enjoy reading for pleasure.
- Continuing to develop retrieval and inference skills.
- Exploring new vocabulary and how it is used in context.



## WRITING

We will be learning to:



- To develop sentences using subordinating clauses.
- Understand the terms 'active' and 'passive' voice and be able to apply this grammatical skill to our own composition.
- Build our understanding of fluidity within writing narratives through the use of cohesive devices, such as conjunctions and time adverbials.

## MATHS

We will be learning about:

- Decimals and percentages and linking these two concepts back to our prior learning of fractions.
- How to measure, draw and identify different types of angles.
- Geometry: we will be able to identify and classify shapes based on their properties.
