

English

In English, we will:

- continue to build reading fluency and comprehension through RWI or reading lessons;
- read *Ruby's Worry* and *The Bear and the Piano*;
- write: stories in role, persuasive letters and non-chronological reports;
- use expanded noun phrases and sentences with different forms.



Maths

In maths, we will be learning to:

- solve problems with addition and subtraction using concrete objects and pictorial representations;
- recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100;
- recognise and use the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction and use this to check calculations and solve missing number problems.

Science

In science, we will be learning about everyday materials. We will:

- compare and classify a variety of everyday materials based on their properties;
- plan an enquiry to test the properties of materials for different uses;
- identify how the shapes of solid objects can be changed.



History

We will be learning about Hackney's history. We will:

- explore why different groups of people migrated to and settled in Hackney;
- learn about the Windrush Generation and when and why they travelled to Britain;
- explore the lives of Caxton Holder and Mrs Riggs by listening to oral history interviews.

Computing

In computing, we will be learning about digital photography. In this unit, we will:

- learn how to take portrait and landscape photographs and when we might choose each format;
- learn what makes a good photo and critique and improve photographs;
- recognise that photographs can be changed and use tools to make changes to our photos.



Physical Education

In PE, we will be focusing on activities that develop our running, jumping and throwing skills. We will also be developing our attacking, defending and shooting skills.

Religious Education

In RE we will be learning about Islamic beliefs. We will:

- explore what is important in our lives;
- learn about the beliefs of Muslims;

- learn about what happens at the celebration of Eid-ul-Fitr and why.



Art and Design

In art lessons, we will explore and draw inspired by the world around us. We will:

- look at the work of artists who use natural objects such as Alice Fox and Andy Goldsworthy;
- collect and compose objects from our local environment;
- combine different drawing media such as wax resist and watercolour, graphite and water, wax crayon and pencil in observational drawings.
