

Early reading enjoyment is the single biggest indicator of a child's future success. (OECD Report, 2002)





Let's get children talking!


BOOK CLUB! (KS2)



Family reading time


- Read with your child.

Reading Diaries KS2



Why are they important?

 Used to capture pupil's thoughts and opinions about a story.



How often?

- One written entry every weekday (5 per week).



How will this be monitored?

- Pupils will need to bring in their Reading Diaries every Monday.
- Class teachers
 will check them
 to make sure
 that they have
 been completed
 from the
 previous week.
