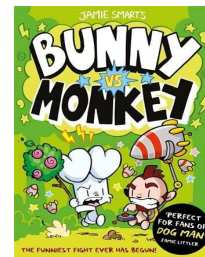
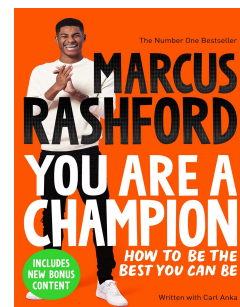
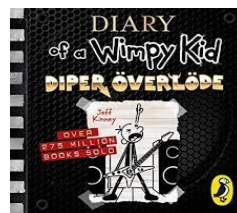


WHY IS READING FOR PLEASURE SO IMPORTANT?

Let's get children talking!

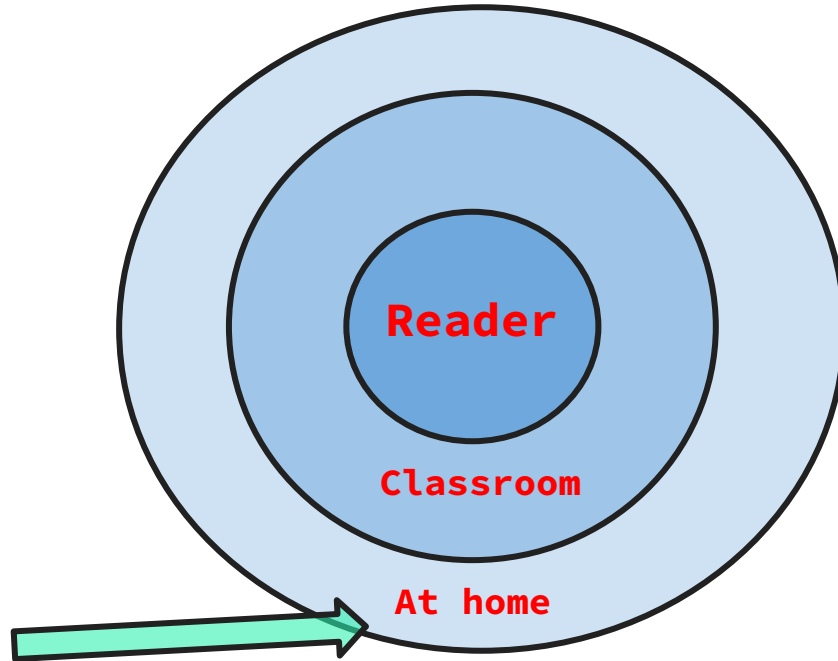
BOOK CLUB! (KS2)

READING DIARIES KS2

- The expectation is that they will do **one entry every weekday**.
- Teachers will check reading diaries in school **every Monday**.
- This will provide families with an opportunity for greater engagement with pupil reading and extend our reading communities.

Friday	The story 'Jumping Mouse' tells me to be generous and you will always get something back.

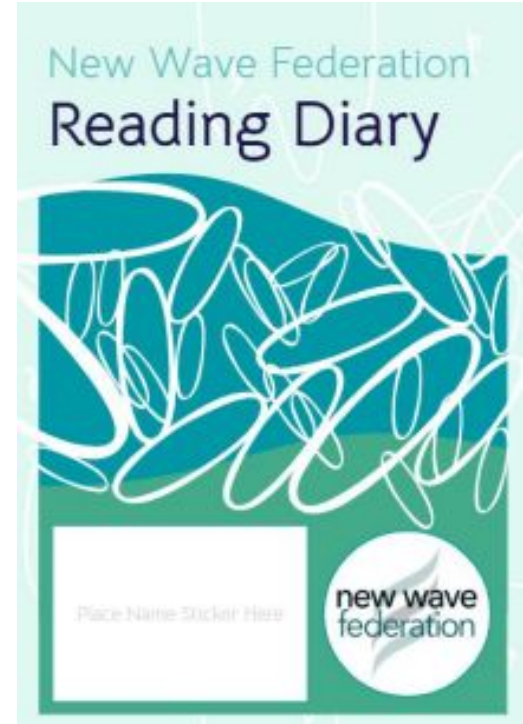

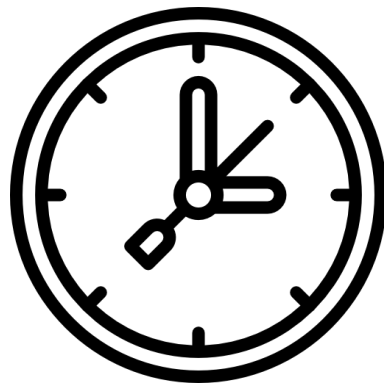

Reading at Home



Read Aloud

- Try to read to your child once a day.
- Read your child a bedtime story / Use CBeebies Bedtime story.



Book Talk

- Ask your child questions about books.
- Recommend authors / illustrators.
- Explore **Book Trust** to find the right book for you!



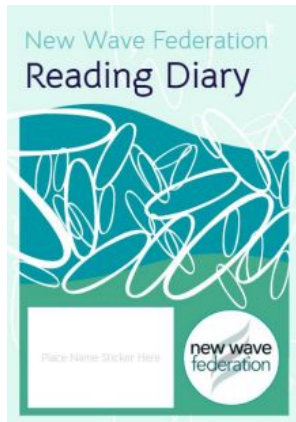
Family reading time

Reading Diaries KS2



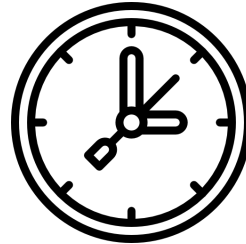
Why are they important?

- Used to capture pupil's thoughts and opinions about a story.

Week Beginning 20 Nov - 25 Nov

Thursday	When Mr. Brunner walked in he handed Percy a pen which turned into a sword. Percy hit Mrs. Danks and she disappeared. Percy turned around and Mr. Brunner was gone.

How often?

- One written entry **every weekday** (5 per week).



How will this be monitored?

- Pupils will need to bring in their Reading Diaries **every Monday**.
- Class teachers will check them to make sure that they have been completed from the previous week.
