In their Reading Diary, they will be required to make a log of the reading they do at home each day as well as record their spelling practice each week. Alongside their own notes, the children will be asked to seek comments and a signature of a parent each week. This will encourage the children to read at home each day and will allow

your child's teacher to closely monitor the books that your child chooses to read.

It is without a doubt that those children who read at home develop a stronger and richer vocabulary and ultimately do better at school.
