Re: Operation Encompass

We would like to let you know that our school works in partnership with the Metropolitan Police Service as part of Operation Encompass.

Operation Encompass is a safeguarding initiative that supports children and young people who may have been exposed to a domestic incident. This includes situations where a child was not directly present but is part of the same household. When such an incident occurs, the police will notify the school before the start of the next school day.

This information is shared confidentially with a specially trained member of staff, known as the Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL). The DSL can then ensure that appropriate care, understanding and support are in place for the child's wellbeing while they are in school.

Where needed, the school may be able to make small adjustments or provide additional support to help the child and their family during this time.

At Woodberry Down, we are committed to offering the best possible support to all our pupils and we believe this partnership is an important part of keeping children safe and supported.
