**Re: Warm Weather**

With the current rise in temperatures and with the BBC forecasting that the hot weather is set to continue next week, we are taking extra steps in school to ensure that all of our children remain safe, healthy and comfortable throughout the day.

We kindly ask for your support with the following:

**Hydration**

Please ensure that your child drinks plenty of fluids before leaving home for school. All children should bring a refillable water bottle with them each day, which they can refill as needed.



**Sun Protection**

Please apply long-lasting sun cream before your child comes to school.



**Hats**

Our children should bring a sun hat to wear during outdoor activities.



**Clothing**

Please dress your child in lightweight, breathable clothing wherever possible. The school's uniform policy allows children to wear pinafore dresses and grey, knee-length shorts.

Please also note:

Avoid vests under T-shirts, as these can cause overheating.  
Children do not need to bring jackets unless rain is forecast.

**Breakfast**

Please ensure that your child has a nutritious breakfast before school to help them stay energised and well throughout the morning.

Throughout the school day, there will be regular water breaks and additional water will be

available in classrooms to help keep our children hydrated. Staff will monitor pupils closely and encourage them to stay cool and take breaks when needed.

We will continue to monitor the weather forecast and will inform you if any changes to the school day become necessary.
