Re: Return to Usual School Hours

I hope this letter finds you well and that you have managed to cope with the intense heat during both the days and evenings this week.

The current forecast indicates that temperatures will return to more typical June levels next week. With this in mind, I am pleased to let you know that, from **Monday 29th June**, we will return to our normal school day.
