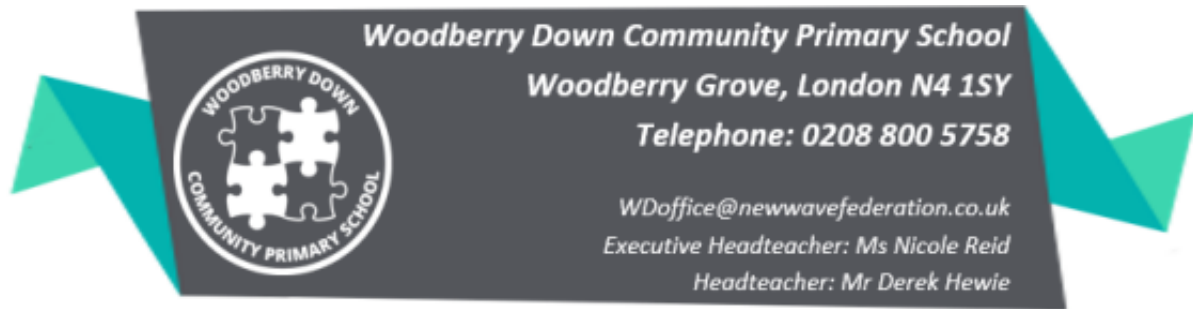

Re: Lunch Arrangements on Friday 17th July

I am writing to provide you with an update regarding the school kitchen refurbishment. I am pleased to let you know that the contractors began their work last week and are currently on track to finish by the end of August.

Throughout the summer, the team will:

- Fully refurbish and replace the entire school kitchen.
- Redecorate the canteen and the toilets in the lower hall.

We are all incredibly excited about this project, which means that we expect to run a full catering service from our brand-new school kitchen starting this September. The temporary kitchen portacabins are scheduled to be removed during the first week of the summer holidays.
