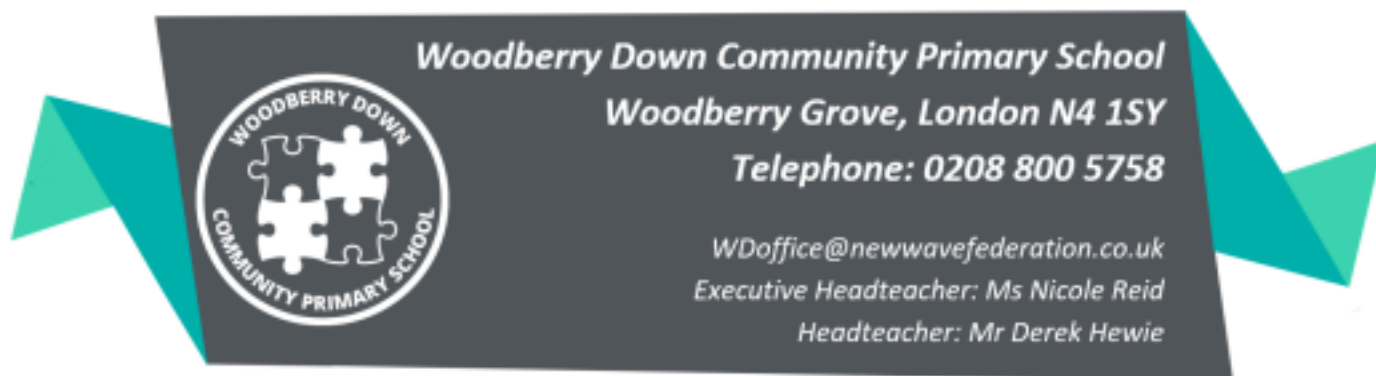

End of Year Reports (Reception to Year 5)

Every child from Reception to Year 5 will receive their end-of-year report by the end of today, Friday 10th July.

Please note the following important details regarding reports:

- **Digital Delivery:** Reports will be shared digitally via the **MCAS (MyChildAtSchool) app** on your mobile phone or tablet.
- **No Paper Copies:** In line with our school procedures, printed paper copies will not be provided.
- **App Support:** If you do not yet have the MCAS app downloaded, please download it to your device as soon as possible. If you require any support with setting up the app or accessing the report, please speak to a member of staff in the school office who will be happy to assist you.

Year 6 Reports Reminder

As previously communicated, our Year 6 families will receive their children's reports next week on Friday 17th July. This is due to the national delay in the release of the Key Stage 2 SATs results by the Department for Education.

Parent Consultation Meetings: Monday 13th July

We will be holding our Parent Consultation meetings this coming Monday 13th July from 3.45pm to 5.30pm. This is a wonderful opportunity to discuss your child's progress and their end-of-year report with their classteacher.
