


## Year 1 Untold Stories Overview

<p>English and PSHE</p>	<p><b>Stories we will share:</b></p> <p>We will share the stories of a diverse range of people who live in our local community.</p> <p>The book, 'All are Welcome' will teach us to be kind to others and the importance of inclusivity.</p> 	<p><b>Our Writing outcomes:</b></p> <p>We will write our own sentences about the animals in our story and how they are similar and different from one another.</p> <p>We will write about ourselves to share what we know about our history. .</p> <p>We will write to inform others about our history and that of the local community.</p>	<p><b>Our PSHE focus:</b></p> <p>The PSHE unit is called celebrating difference. We are going to read stories that help us to learn what makes us the same and what makes us unique .</p> <p>We are then going to find out about the people in our community at school and in our classroom in order to celebrate where we are from and what makes us unique.</p>
<p>Cross Curricular Links</p>	<p><b>Links to our History Topic:</b></p> <p>We will be exploring 'Living History' by sharing the stories of a diverse range of people in our community. We will also be finding out about the stories of people who migrated to Hackney from around the world. We will compare and contrast these stories to our own experiences of childhood!</p> 	<p><b>Links to our Science Topic:</b></p> <p>We will be learning all about the properties of materials and considering how different materials are used to help people around the world. We will be learning about Mary Seacole and the materials she used to help those in need.</p>	<p><b>Other curriculum links:</b></p> <p>In our music assemblies, we will learn the untold stories of musicians and performers of the music that we are exploring.</p> <p>In DT we will be learning about mechanisms such as levers and look at how they are used in a range of contexts around the world.</p>
<p>Enriched Learning</p>	<p><b>Community Engagement:</b></p> <p>We would love our community to tell us their untold stories, particularly if it links to our theme of family history. <b>Do you have a story to share with year 1?</b></p> <p>We will be sharing lots of the learning with you all through our digital communication channels so keep an eye out for updates.</p>	<p><b>Enrichment Opportunities:</b></p> <p>The children will participate in theatre workshops delivered by performing arts companies: Freshwater Theatre Company and Hackney Shed. These workshops will explore the themes of migration and what makes us the same and what makes us unique.</p>	<p><b>Home learning:</b></p> <p>The children will be given a maker mat with creative tasks linked to our project.
