Q. Do we have to do all of the work set?

Please don't feel you need to complete every single activity as we know how challenging it can be working from home. Complete what you can manage. We suggest focusing on maths and literacy first and then see what you have time for.

We do ask that your child attends the live sessions each week. This helps our teachers to check in with children and share messages. Let us know if you are unable to attend the Tuesday live sessions.

Q. When will my child see their teacher online?

To keep our team safe, we are operating a rota system which means that some staff come into school, whilst others work from home. Depending on the week, you might see more of one teacher than another in the online videos.
