Dear Families,

Re: Lateral Flow Testing for those without symptoms of COVID-19

We are writing to you with further details about the wider opening of Woodberry Down to all pupils on Monday 8th March.

Many of you will have experienced the closure of a year group bubble this academic year and the disruption to your child's learning that this causes. As such, we would like to do all that we can to try to reduce the possibility of this occurring when all the children return to school.

We know that the majority of young children do not show symptoms of COVID-19 if they contract the virus. We have therefore signed up to a Hackney pilot lateral flow testing scheme which we will trial with Year 3 and Year 4 this term. Further details will be sent to those year groups shortly. However, in order to maintain the safety of all pupils and staff and to reduce the risk of asymptomatic cases of COVID-19 in the school from Monday, we are asking that you consider taking your child to get a lateral flow test at one of the centres in Hackney or Haringey before the 8th March.

There are a number of lateral flow/rapid testing sites close by. Please find the details listed below. You can click on the link for each centre to book a test.
