**Re: Year 6 summer residential trip 2021**

As you are aware, it was not possible for our year 6 pupils to participate in our annual PGL residential trip in February. We are pleased to let you know that current government guidelines state that schools can plan overnight residentials when restrictions are lifted on the 21st June.

We have booked Suntrap Forest Centre in Chingford from **Monday 28th June- Wednesday 30th June 2021**. This is a local alternative that offers a range of exciting activities (see example timetable below). The children will sleep in heated 'eco pods' in groups of four with toilet, shower and dining room facilities close by. Our school will have exclusive access to the centre during our stay and will not be mixing with any other groups.
